**Counselor Information Sheet Set Free After Care Assistance requirements**

The Set Free After Care Ministry attempts to provide aftercare assistance to qualified applicants who are soon to be paroled or discharged. We trust these requirements provide clarification to those who apply. Unfortunately we cannot provide aftercare assistance to all applicants just because they are homeless and no where to parole to; only those that have made a definite commitment to change their lives need apply. We are limited with space and resources in providing help.

Listed below are the requirements and guidelines we incorporated:

1. The inmate must have a referral by a Chaplain or Counselor. No consideration will be made without this referral.
2. Upon our office receiving a completed application, please allow 2 weeks for the Set Free After Care Ministry to process the application and reply to inmate.
3. The inmate must allow the Department of Corrections to share relevant information with Set Free After Care Ministry Director or assigned by signing the Release of Information Form on #2 & #5.
4. We do not accept anyone that will partake of alcohol and/or drugs, smoking after release. You will be drug tested while you are in our program and a failure is grounds for immediate dismissal.
5. **\*\*\*We Do Not Accept Any Sex Related Offenses or smokers\*\*\***
6. An important part of the After Care Program is counseling, the inmate must be willing to seek and follow through with counseling, public or private. The inmate will be required to attend and participate in church on a weekly basis.
7. The inmate understands that a great deal of responsibility rests on him for a successful re-entry into society. The Set Free After Care Ministry Program will provide informational leads, but it's the determination of the inmate to seek and secure resources by his own efforts.
8. The inmate agrees to fully accept all requirements of the Set Free After Care Program. If accepted into Set Free After Care Program, the Director and inmate will sign an agreement covering what is expected of him. Inmates who receive aftercare applications and forms are not guaranteed acceptance. The applicant is screened and approved by the Director of the Set Free After Care Ministry. After approval, the inmate will be notified and placed on a waiting list for a residence plan with Set Free After Care Ministry.

**\*\*\*Note: Form #2 page 5 , There is an up front fee of \$500. IF the inmate is indignant, has no money on his books and no family support, this fee can be waived, send the application.**

**\*\*\*Please send a resume for the inmate.**

**\*\*\*All forms must be completed and returned to Set Free After Care Ministry before any consideration will be given for help! To protect the Counselor and Chaplain's comments and confidentiality all forms should be mailed by the counselor NOT the inmate. The inmate must have his birth certificate and social security card in his file ,confirmed by counselor, before we accept his application.**

This is his "SECOND CHANCE" for his mistakes, it is his responsibility to get these documents before being released. If he is released and is not accepted because he didn't take care of this the parole board is not going to be happy and he won't get a third chance to start over.
